

Hindenburg History Paper

You may or many not have heard of the Hindenburg disaster. However, the Hindenburg disaster has many correlations to what we have done in experiment 4.8. Your job now is to report on the Hindenburg and how it does relate to what we've done in class. Your paper needs to do the following:

- Explain what the Hindenburg is.
- Explain what the Hindenburg disaster was and when it occurred.
- Describe at least 3 possible reasons for the disaster, and explaining what is the most likely reason and WHY. Your opinion.
- Justify how the Hindenburg disaster relates to class.

Your paper **MUST** have the following specifications. Points will be taken off if you do not follow these:

- Cover page with name, date and hour (picture if you want).
- Margins set at 1". (NOT 1.25" which is what it is set at when you open up Microsoft Word)
- 12 point font – New Times Roman or Cambria (Body)
- 1 – 2 pages in length.
- Double spaced
- No skipping lines between paragraphs
- Works Cited or Bibliography of where you obtained your information (NO WIKIPEDIA)

This will be due on **Friday, February 14, 2014** at the beginning of your hour.

Plagiarism will not be tolerated! If I suspect any type of plagiarism (copying from somebody in class, using somebody else's paper, not using your own words, etc.) you will receive a **0** for your paper.

The paper will be worth **75 points**, which will go towards your classwork/homework grade.
